

# Jaime supports bipartisan bill to lower drug prices

“I’ve witnessed folks close to me struggle with chronic conditions and illness, and they’re forced to rely on increasingly expensive medication to manage their health. Congress can’t delay any longer to make prescription drugs more affordable for folks who rely on them – the status quo is simply unacceptable,” Jaime said.

“H.R. 3 would place a cap on the amount

seniors pay out-of-pocket for prescriptions at \$2,000 a year. It would require drug companies to disclose truthful pricing information when advertising.

“No one should have to deplete their retirement savings to pay for heart medication or risk their life rationing insulin,” Jaime said. H.R. 3 passed the House December 12.

*“No Southwest Washington senior should have to choose between paying rent or filling a costly cancer treatment prescription,” Jaime said.*
