Better Access for Children

Congressman Brown secured funding for a pediatric telehealth network that provides equipment and technical expertise to directly connect students in 100 Prince George's County public schools to online physical and mental health care and treatment.

"A steward of the project since its inception," Congressman Brown brought the new 205 bed state-of-the-art University of Maryland Capital Region Medical Center to Largo. With a floor dedicated to heart and vascular care, a maternity center and inpatient and outpatient behavioral health services, the new facility provides access to the quality care our region desperately needed and deserves.



Expanded Coverage for Toxic-Exposed Veterans

As a military veteran, Congressman Brown knows we must honor our pact with servicemembers by ensuring those who are exposed to environmental hazards and other toxic substances during their service will have their care and treatment covered.

Brown's Honoring Our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics Act of 2021, which has now passed the House of Representatives, ensures servicemembers are covered for the full gamut of toxic exposures during service – from airborne hazards from burn pits to Agent Orange and radiation from atomic testing and cleanup.

Protected Affordable Care Act

Brown has steadfastly and successfully defended the Affordable Care Act against every attempt to weaken or eliminate the critical coverage and affordable care it provides.

Capping Insulin Costs

Brown helped pass the Affordable Insulin Now Act that limits the cost of insulin to \$35 per month.

Lower Cost of Medicine

Brown is a co-sponsor of legislation to get more affordable generic versions of prescription drugs to market sooner and to allow Medicare to negotiate lower prices for medicine.

Reduced Insurance Premiums

According to the White House, as a result of the American Rescue Plan supported by Congressman Brown and signed into law, thousands of Maryland families saved an average of \$800 per person last year through lower monthly health insurance premiums.
