## Improving Our Schools

### Back To School: In-Person Learning

As schools return to normalcy following the COVID-19 public health emergency, we must ensure every child receives the education they deserve from in-person instruction. I am a proud cosponsor of H.R. 682, the Reopen Schools Act, which would require local school districts to return to in-person learning before receiving any additional COVID-19 emergency relief funding. We have seen the devastating effects that school closures have had on our students' learning, and we must ensure that every child has the opportunity to learn in-person in the classroom.

### More Transparency For Parents

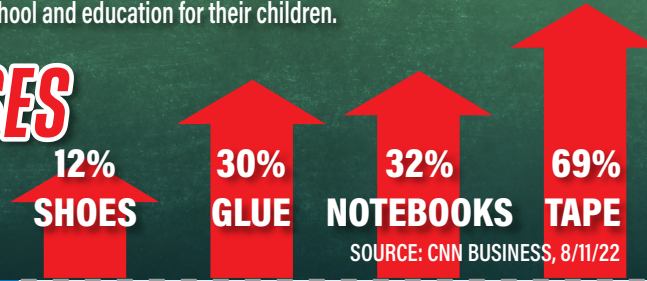
Every parent and guardian has the right to know what is being taught in their children's school. For this reason, I cosponsored two bills—H.R. 6056, the Parents Bill of Rights Act and H.R. 5162, the Curriculum Review of Teachings Transparency Act—which would require all school districts to make their school curriculum public. Parents know what's best for their children, and they have the right to weigh in on what is being taught.

### Quality Education For Every Child

All children deserve a quality education. Parents and guardians know their child best and should have the opportunity to choose the school where their child will thrive. As the Co-Chair of the Congressional Public Schools Caucus, I am proud to have introduced H.R. 5959, the Creating Hope and Opportunity for Individuals and Communities through Education Act, which would expand school choice programs and provide more quality education options. I also cosponsored H.R. 7525, the Protecting Charter Schools from Federal Overreach Act, which would ensure that the U.S. Department of Education is not unfairly targeting charter schools with burdensome regulations to force these schools to close. I will continue to fight for every family to choose the best school and education for their children.
