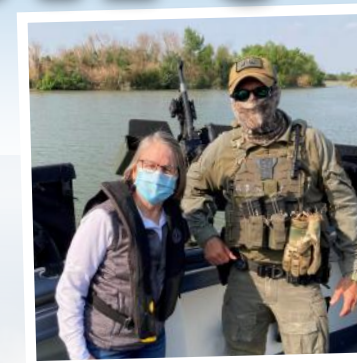


FIGHTING TO LOWER THE COST OF INSULIN

No one should struggle to pay for basic, life-saving medication, yet the price of insulin has skyrocketed. I was proud to vote in favor of H.R. 6833, the Affordable Insulin Now Act, which would cap the price of insulin at \$35, making it more affordable and accessible for every American.

FIGHTING FOR FARMERS

Like most Iowans, I understand the importance of farming, and I have continuously worked to support farmers during my time in Congress. I have introduced legislation to provide clarity about how the federal government can regulate bodies of water – including water located on private farmland. I also have and will continue to push for lower fuel prices by allowing E15 to be sold year-round and to maintain stepped-up basis to protect our family farmers.



SECURING OUR BORDER

Border security is national security, and we have all seen the impact of failed policies from Washington at our southern border. I have cosponsored legislation to restart construction of our southern border wall, provide funding and support to our brave law enforcement officers, and require the deployment of effective and innovative technologies at the border. This illegal immigration crisis has proven that every state is a border state, and Iowans deserve a secure border.

COMMUNITY FUNDED PROJECTS

This year I secured funding for eight congressionally-directed Community Projects that will bring \$55.5 million to Iowa for vital infrastructure and programs, including funding to repair a bridge in Scott County, build a transit facility in Iowa City, and reconstruct Highway 38 in Cedar County. I am also working to secure funding for twelve more projects, including repairing 18th Street near the national cemetery in Keokuk and flood monitoring across eastern Iowa.



FORMULA

No parent should have to go through the worry and stress of finding formula for their newborn. I am a proud cosponsor of H.R. 7830, the Babies Need More Formula Now Act, which would increase the supply of baby formula and would provide oversight to the Food and Drug Administration to make sure this crisis never happens again.

SUPPORTING STUDENTS

As a mother of two, I understand that parents know what's best for their child and should have a say in their child's education. I was proud to introduce H.R. 5959, the Creating Hope and Opportunity for Individuals and Communities through Education (CHOICE) Act, which would expand school choice for K-12 students and allow parents to find the best education fit for their child.

TELEHEALTH

Telehealth proved to be extremely beneficial during the COVID-19 pandemic and should remain a permanent fixture in healthcare. As a member of the Healthy Futures Task Force, I am proud to cosponsor legislation that would permanently extend and improve telehealth benefits and services to Americans.

KEEPING OUR PROMISES TO VETERANS

As an Army veteran and doctor, I was proud to vote for the Sergeant First Class Heath Robinson Honoring Our PACT Act. This law will eliminate bureaucratic red tape and ensure veterans who were exposed to toxic substances from burn pits and other sources receive the care and benefits they deserve.

MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION

As a physician and former Iowa Director of Public Health, I am proud to have sponsored and passed legislation in Congress to support pediatric mental and behavioral health services and to increase access to opioid addiction treatment programs. I am also proud to have introduced and had signed into law H.R. 2591, the Dispose Unused Medications and Prescription Opioids Act, which would allow people to dispose controlled substances medications in safe locations.



SUPPORTING OUR MILITARY AND VETERANS

I am proud to have introduced and had signed into law H.R. 4300, the Alexander Lofgren Veterans in Parks (VIP) Act. This legislation provides veterans and Gold Star families free lifetime access to national parks and public federal lands and provides free annual passes to active-duty military. I will continue to honor our servicemembers and veterans in Congress.
