Congressman Mike Lawler's Personal Commitment to Protecting Seniors

- ★ **Rep. Lawler signed onto H.Res 109**, which reaffirms his commitment to preserve and protect Social Security for current beneficiaries as well as for future generations.
- ★ **Rep. Lawler co-sponsored H.R. 82, the Social Security Fairness Act**, which prevents Social Security benefits from being taken away from individuals who receive pensions or disability benefits from other employers. He also co-sponsored H.R. 875, which authorizes the U.S. Treasury to continue making Social Security and Medicare payments regardless of the debt ceiling.
- ★ **Rep. Lawler's own father benefited from Social Security Disability** while he battled Multiple Sclerosis and Melanoma, before ultimately succumbing to cancer at the age of 54; and his grandfather received excellent care during his near-death battle with COVID-19 three years ago thanks to Medicare.
- ★ **Rep. Lawler has already secured hundreds of thousands of dollars** from Social Security, Medicare and the IRS rightfully owed to Hudson Valley seniors and will continue to fight on your behalf in Congress.
