Restoring Trust by Reforming Government

Dear John,

Washington is broken. I know it. You know it. Everyone knows it. That's why I'm leading my Blueprint for a Better America to reform our broken system and get the government back on track for the American people.

Today, I unveiled four pieces of legislation to begin restoring the trust that's been broken by partisan politics, including:

- **The Make It Count Act** to end the circus of redistricting for a political advantage by limiting when and how congressional districts are drawn.
- **The Supermajority Statehood Amendment** to require a two-thirds supermajority vote in both the House and Senate to add a new state to the union.
- **The Keep the Nine Amendment** to put an end to the partisan efforts to pack the U.S. Supreme Court by permanently limiting it to nine justices.
- **The Unauthorized Spending Accountability Act** to force Congress to reclaim the "power of the purse" and review, rethink, and possibly eliminate [\\$516 billion](#) in programs that are running on autopilot.
